Introduction

This handbook is for information purposes only. Delegates are advised to visit the ICC Review Conference Website at www.ICCUGANDA2010.ug for more detailed and current information.

About the Review Conference

The International Criminal Court (ICC) Review Conference is scheduled to take place from 31st May - 11 June 2010 in Kampala, Uganda. The Conference is a gathering of great significance expected to bring together between 1500 and 2000 delegates from all corners of the globe. Participation in the Conference shall be open to representatives of states parties to the Rome Statute, observer states, states not having observer status, representatives designated by intergovernmental organizations and other entities that have received a standing invitation from the General Assembly of the United Nations, representatives designated by regional intergovernmental organizations or other international bodies invited to the Rome Conference (of 1998), representatives of subsidiary bodies of the Assembly of States Parties, officials and staff of the ICC, officials and staff of the United Nations, non-governmental organizations invited to the Rome Conference and other persons accredited or invited to attend the Conference (including representatives of press, radio, film, television or other information media).

The Conference shall take place in Kampala at Munyonyo Commonwealth Resort on the shores of Lake Victoria, 12 kilometers from the city centre.

In terms of article 123 of the Rome Statute, the Review Conference to be held in Kampala will not only be the first one but also the only one whose convening is statutory. Uganda is, therefore, specially honored to host this important meeting.

Uganda first offered to host the Review Conference as far back as June 2007 during a meeting of the Special Working Group on the Crime of Aggression at Princeton University. This offer was informed by the conviction that by states parties coming to the region which has borne the brunt of the last century's worst atrocities, the victims would appreciate that they are indeed the reason why the Court exists. It would also provide an excellent opportunity for the Court to be better understood and appreciated.

Uganda is proud to be one of the countries that have spearheaded the cause for justice at national and international levels over the years. Uganda was one of the first 60 states parties to ratify the Rome Statute and in 2003, it was the first country to refer a situation to the ICC. It is no secret that the level of cooperation proffered to the Court since then is yet to be matched.

Uganda is no stranger to hosting high-profile international conferences; this is aptly demonstrated by the successful hosting in November 2007 of the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) where Her Majesty the Queen of Great Britain was among the guests.

The Government of Uganda looks forward to a successful conference.

Registration and Accreditation

As agreed between the Government of Uganda and the Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties (ASP), registration and accreditation of delegates to the Review Conference shall be carried out by the Secretariat of the ASP directly just as it is done for ordinary sessions of the ASP. The delegates' particulars will then be forwarded to the ICC Review Conference Secretariat in Kampala, Uganda for purposes of coordination, identification at immigration points and issuance of identification badges at the conference venue.

Transportation

Accredited delegates will have transport provided from Entebbe International airport to the various hotels and from the hotels (and specific designated pick-up points to the conference venue at Munyonyo Commonwealth Resort). However, transport fare from the city centre of Kampala to Munyonyo commonwealth resort is approximately \$15 (about 30,000 Ushs) by a special hire cab.

Entebbe International airport is connected to Kampala by a forty kilometers road. Private transport facilities are also available at Entebbe Airport and these include airport taxis and car rentals. Airport taxis are marked in yellow and are labeled 'AIRPORT TAXI'. Passengers are advised to take note of the taxi identification and registration numbers for reference purposes in case they hire one. Hiring an airport taxi to Kampala costs about \$25 (approximately 50,000 Ushs) and the journey would normally take 40 minutes save for those times when the traffic is heavy; that is, from 8 am to 9 am and 5 pm to 6.30 pm local time.

Public transport provided by commuters is also available between the airport and Kampala. Commuters also operate the Airport - Entebbe Town route. Commuters

charge about \$1 (approximately 2000 Ushs) per passenger (including hand luggage) from Entebbe to Kampala City. Though Dollar notes are widely acceptable in Uganda, delegates are advised to carry some Uganda currency notes.

Various Forex bureaus at Entebbe International Airport provide foreign exchange services.

A good number of tour and travel agents operate in Kampala. Some Tour and Travel companies have information desks at the airport as well.

Flying to Uganda: What you need to know

Flight Information

Entebbe International Airport maintains a 24-hour hotline (+ 256 414 320926) that provides information about airport operations. This is complemented by various display boards, screens and information desks located in the passenger terminal building. For detailed information please contact airline offices, passenger handling companies or the information desk on Tel. +256 31/41 353000

Baggage facilities/lost-found and left luggage

Misconnected and lost baggage is reported to the Ground Handling Company office at the Arrival hall, or the airline on which the passenger arrived. For items lost while at the Airport, a report is made to the Aviation Security Office located on the Departures floor. The Baggage Tracing office is located at the Arrivals baggage claim area, ground floor on a 24-hour basis. Passenger self-help-baggage trolleys are found in the forecourt of departure level, and baggage reclaim area on arrival. Passenger handling staff assists the elderly and disabled. There is a Baggage Information display board at each baggage claim belts. The belt on which your arrival flight number is indicated will deliver your baggage. Contact the baggage tracing office if you cannot find your baggage.

Airline Lounge/Travel Clubs

There is a privately managed departure lounge, which renders world-class service in a natural setting, complete with water fountains and beautiful flora. Invitation to the lounge is made by the airline of your choice, depending on the class of travel or your commercial relation with it. Passengers travelling by economy class can use the facility at US\$15 for every two to three hours.

V.I.P Lounge

The VIP lounge is a Government facility. Certain Government officials and the diplomatic community are entitled to VIP lounge services. Prior application and clearance must be obtained from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for special cases.

Facilities for passengers with special needs

Lifts, ramps, wheelchairs, covered walkways and help line services are available. Passenger handling staff assists the elderly and the disabled. They also attend to special needs passengers.

Duty Free Shopping

Uganda Duty Free Sales, Transit Duty Free sales operate three easily accessible shops on departure. There is similar facility for arriving passengers, which enables you to carry less from abroad and buy more on Arrival. Liquors, exotic wines, tobacco, toys, watches, fragrances, chocolates and a variety of other local products and gift items are in stock. To order in advance, contact Sales on udfs@starcom.co.ug. Diplomats' Duty Free offering a variety of goods is located on the landside, 2nd Floor and operates during office hours Monday to Saturday.

Departure information

There is no Customs desk on departure at Entebbe International Airport. Departing passengers are required to present a valid passport or other travel document and completed departure embarkation card to the immigration officer. The officer will ascertain that the traveler obtained the relevant Visa. The travel documents is duly stamped and returned to the passenger. Passengers then proceed to the departure-transit concourse for duty-free shopping and refreshments. After the final security formalities, passengers get into the holding-area where one can ascertain their belongings, tickets, passports, traveler's checks etc. At all the stages, Airport staff are on hand to provide needed information or desired service.

Visa Information

A visa to Uganda is issued at any of the Uganda diplomatic missions abroad (*See page 62 for details*) and entry points. All countries that require visas for Uganda are also visa-prone in Uganda.

Nationals of the countries listed below are exempted from visa requirements for travel to Uganda. They do, however, need to have a current passport issued by their respective countries.

Certain COMESA member states and all East African Community member states: Burundi, Comoros, Eritrea, Kenya, Malawi, Mauritius, Madagascar, Rwanda, Seychelles, Swaziland, Tanzania, Zambia and Zimbabwe.

Others exempted are: Antigua & Barbuda, The Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Fiji, Gambia, Grenada, Jamaica, Lesotho, Malta, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Solomon Islands St Vincent & the Grenadines, Tonga, Vanuatu, Italy (Only diplomatic passport holders) and Cyprus.

Visa Requirements:

1. One fully filled Application form by each applicant,
2. Every section of the application form must be completed. Incomplete forms will not be processed.
3. 2 passport size photographs
4. Must submit original Passport valid past the date of your expected departure from Uganda.
5. Letter of invitation/introduction, if traveling on business.
6. Applicants may be requested to submit additional supporting documentation.

You are advised to ensure that your passport has a validity of at least six months from the date of your intended travel.

Visa fees and other details

The Government of Uganda has waived visa fees for all participants in the Review Conference. Participants from those countries where Uganda has diplomatic presence are advised to obtain visas from the respective embassies/high commissions or consulates. For those countries where Uganda does not have diplomatic presence, visas may be obtained on arrival at Entebbe International Airport at designated counters. Delegates are advised to carry with them evidence of accreditation or invitation by the Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties.

The visa enables the holder to proceed to a port of entry where he/she must comply with the laws and regulations governing the admission of persons to the Republic of Uganda

Health Information

Delegates are advised to contact the Uganda in their countries or regions to determine whether vaccination is necessary before entry into Uganda. A yellow fever vaccination is usually required.

Delegates are fully responsible for arranging their own health insurance. In Uganda, International Hospital Kampala (IHK) provides international health insurance. This is offered to holders of the following cards: Bupa Card, Good Health Card and Aetna Card.

The Government of Uganda (GoU) shall provide adequate medical facilities for first aid in emergencies within the conference area. Immediate access and admission to hospitals will be assured by the GoU whenever required, and the necessary transport shall be constantly available on call. The medical costs arising, if any, will be covered by the participant.

Airlines at Entebbe

Entebbe International Airport is the principal international airport of Uganda and is located forty kilometers south-west of Kampala, the Capital of Uganda.

Entebbe international Airport is linked to all major cities and airlines all over the world for both passenger and cargo handling services. Uganda flight providers include British Airways, SN-Brussels, Kenya Airways, KLM Royal Dutch Airlines, Air Tanzania, Ethiopian Airways, Emirates, Rwanda Air, South African Airways, Egypt Air and East African Airways. The local flights are provided by Eagle Air, Dairo Air and United Airlines. These providers also fly to Juba, Southern Sudan. Most of these airlines have country offices in Kampala and also at Entebbe International Airport (Passenger terminal building, 2nd Floor).

The majority of the flights into Uganda pass through Nairobi, Kenya but there are others with direct flights to Entebbe and these include British Airways, KLM, South African Airways, Air Tanzania and Egypt Air. Air charter services to various locations within Uganda and East Africa are also available on request.

The following list provides basic information about airlines operating in Uganda. All these airline companies have online booking systems and some provide telephone reservation services. Delegates are advised to visit the various airline websites for details regarding services offered.

Currency Exchange

The Uganda shilling is the legal currency in Uganda. There are no restrictions on money transfer in and out of the country. The Uganda shilling is divided into denominations of 1000, 5000, 10,000, 20,000 and 50,000 for paper notes, while coins are in the denominations of 50,100, 200,500. Commercial banking and Bureau de Change services are available at the Departures and Arrivals level at Entebbe International Airport. Delegates could make use of this facility to convert their home country currencies into Uganda shillings. Banks/Forex bureaus located at the airport include Norfrax Forex Bureau (24 hrs service), Orient Bank (0830 - 1200 hrs), Jetset Forex Bureau (24 hr service) and Stanbic Bank (0830 - 1500 hrs (Mon.-Fri)). Bureau de Change services are also available on virtually every street in Kampala. Delegates are advised to carry Traveller's Cheques instead of large sums of cash. However, payment in hotels can be made by cash, credit cards or traveler's cheques depending on the hotel. Visa, Diners, American Express & Master Card are accepted. *Please note that hotels and forex bureaus don't accept US dollar bills issued in 1996 or the preceding years.*

Electric Appliances

The electric capacity of most common gadgets in Uganda is 240 Volts. British Standard BS 1363 specifies the most common type of domestic AC power plugs and sockets that are used in Uganda. Delegates are however advised to carry universal power adapters.

Dietry Information

Uganda's culture weaves a thread of variety not only through the manner of dress, language and other characteristics but also in its variety of dishes depending on location, climate and history. The staple food eaten by the locals includes cassava, sweet potatoes, millet bread, chicken, pork and beef. Then there is the popular "Luwombo", a delicious stew steamed in banana leaves, and "matooke", a staple made from bananas and served with millet. Ugandan fresh water fish, especially the Nile Perch and Tilapia, are very tasty and worth a try. Other water food dishes include tilapia fish (locally known as "ngege"), mud fish (mamba fish) and other kinds of fish of excellent quality. Soups are also a popular Ugandan food. There is chilled tomato soup, garlic soup, and various kinds of fish soups which are very popular. The most important ingredient which is used in Uganda cooking is cow ghee. Other ingredients used include onions, and the serving of matooke and sorghum or millet porridge with most meals. Fruit or dairy products are used as desserts. On most occasions in Uganda, vegetables are more likely to be served as dessert. Various restaurants and hotels in Kampala also offer cuisines of all types - Continental, Indian, Chinese, Afro-Caribbean, Ethiopian, German, Belgian, French and many others

The local popular local gin is called "waragi" or "Uganda Waragi - the spirit of Uganda" which is a distillate of banana wine. The name "waragi" was coined by Sudanese soldiers from the Turkish word "arrak'h". Towards the end of the 20th century, when British explorers were beginning to make inroads into East Africa, they used brigades of Nubian soldiers in their entourage who concocted the drink that came to be known as "waragi" from grains to keep up their spirits.

You can also catch yourself ice cream at Santos Ice Cream Parlor One of the most popular ice cream shops in Kampala. They have all sorts of ice cream flavors.

Light and heavy lager beers are on sale in many places in Uganda. Bell Beer which has been brewed at Luzira, in the outskirts of Kampala for over 50 years is a popular light beer. Heavy lagers such as Nile Special and Club are brewed at the source of the Nile. Beer prices in Uganda range from 2000 (approximately 1 US dollar) - 6000 Ushs

(approximately 3 US dollars) depending on the sophistication of the pub. In fact one brewer has now started making industrial beer using locally grown sorghum instead of the imported hops and malt. Whatever your brand and taste, you will surely enjoy your beer in Uganda.

There are number of restaurants, all around Kampala, offering different kinds of food. These include standard domestic restaurants with very good food where average lunch costs about 6 dollars (about 12,000 Ushs). There are also a variety of uptown restaurants offering Italian, French, Indian or other cuisines, where average lunch costs from 16 up to 50 dollars (about 32,000 – 100,000 Ushs)

Tourist Attractions

Once described as the "Pearl of Africa" by Sir Winston Churchill, Uganda is a land of great beauty with breathtaking sceneries and a rich cultural heritage. These include the Kigezi highlands in the Southwest (commonly referred to as the Switzerland of Africa), the legendary Ruwenzori Mountains in the west of the country, the Elgon astride the Kenya/Uganda border and Mt. Moroto in the north east all of which give Uganda a picturesque scene to behold. The Ruwenzori range, also known as "Mountains of the Moon" is covered by luxuriant alpine vegetation and impressive snow - capped peaks.

The country enjoys abundant natural water resources. Among them are lakes such as Edward, Albert, Kyoga, George and Victoria. Uganda has the largest share of Lake Victoria (the biggest fresh water lake in Africa) and the source of the famous River Nile, the longest river in the world. It starts its long journey at Jinja through The Sudan and Egypt to the Mediterranean Sea. The River is most famous for its breathtaking waterfalls at Murchison and Bujagali.

There are many historical sites and monuments, the most prestigious being the Kasubi Tombs where four former Buganda kings are buried. The impressive Namugongo Martyrs Shrine is the site where 22 Christian converts were executed on the orders of Kabaka Mwanga II (King of Buganda) in 1886. The victims were canonized by the Pope in 1969. The site has been host to two Popes (1969 & 1993), and thousands of other religious, political and civic celebrities.

There are seven national parks in Uganda namely: Queen Elizabeth, Kidepo, Murchison Falls, Semliki, Bwindi Impenetrable Forest (mountain gorillas), Mount Elgon national Park and Lake Mburo National Park plus a chain of other game reserves.

The extremely rare and endangered mountain gorilla can be found in the Muhavura Ranges and Bwindi Impenetrable Forest. Of the estimated 300-600 mountain gorillas remaining in the world, three-quarters are believed to be in these forests.

There are many bird species in the Semliki Forest where pygmies live. The Crested Crane is the Ugandan national emblem. Other attractions are Makerere University, National Theatre, Uganda National Museum, Independence Monument, Parliament Building, Nommo Gallery, Kabaka's coronation site at Naggalabi, Buddo. The Kabaka's Lake in the suburbs of the city is the largest man-made lake in Africa. The lake was reportedly dug out on the orders of Mwanga in the 1880's as an escape corridor to Lake Victoria. Prayer houses at Rubaga, Namirembe, Kibuli, the Baha'i Temple at Kikaya Hill and the Hindu Temple in the City Centre are some of the century-old structures worth a visit.

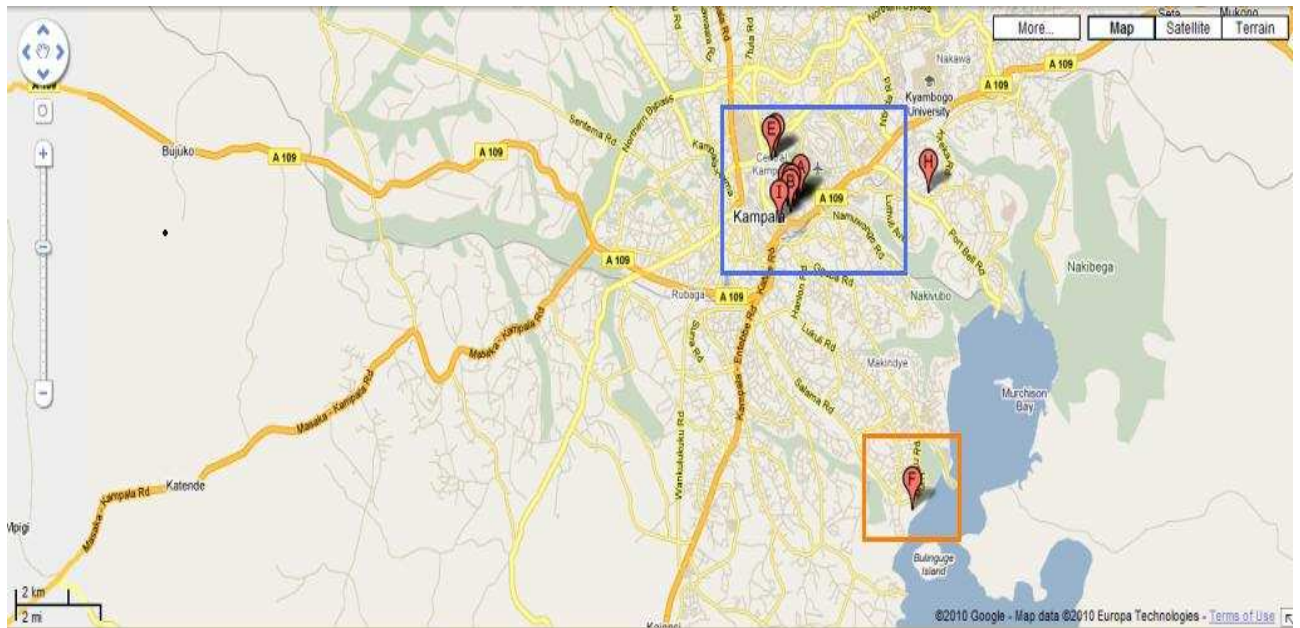
Appendix A: Map of Uganda
